



There is no military version of the Artsakh conflict settlement. This was stated by the Secretary General of the Collective Security Treaty Organization Nikolay Bordyuzha at the meeting with the journalists on June 27.

" I think that only the peaceful negotiations will provide with the opportunity to settle this quite a difficult and long-term issue. There is no other way to settle it" -said Nikolay Bordyuzha. The Secretary General of the Collective Security Treaty Organization spoke about the conflicts, which took place in the region in the 90s and gave numerous victims. "Some political figures have just forgotten about that bitter experience. They should remember what happened in the 90s freeze their hot heads" , -stated Nikolay Bordyuzha, as reported by Armenpress.

It did not differ from the previous announcements. The speech contained the same beaten words about Azerbaijan's "advantages", "Azerbaijan's flag soon buoying over Karabakh", ect.
