

Author plans to spread book on the Armenian Genocide survivors' testimonies

The ethnographer, folklorist and public figure Vezhine Svazlyan plans to spread her book representing 700 unit testimonies of witness – survivors of the Armenian Genocide all over the world ahead of the 100th anniversary of the Armenian Genocide.

In a conversation with the journalists the author told that on the occasion of her 80th anniversary and 60th anniversary of her scientific activity she will send "Armenian genocide: testimonies of witness – survivors" book to all the libraries of Armenia's provinces, as well as libraries of the USA and Europe in the coming future. "I'd like to send the Armenian, Russian and English versions of the book to the centers engaged in studying genocide, as well as to Museums. 100th anniversary is ahead, and I think it will play its role to inform the whole world about what happened," Vezhine Svazlyan said. According to her, the work is the voice of the Armenian people which she raised to scientific level.
